

# Participate in the City of Twentynine Palms' Redistricting Process

**What is redistricting?** Redistricting is the process of adjusting City Council voting district lines in accordance with population shifts. In California, public agencies and other organizations must redraw the lines of their districts every 10 years following the release of Census data so that each district is equal in population. This process ensures that each City Council member represents close to the same number of constituents.

**Why is redistricting important?** Redistricting determines which neighborhoods and communities are grouped together into a voting district for the purpose of electing a City Councilmember. Fair, representative districts help ensure that elected officials will be responsive to the residents in their communities.

### Public Hearing #4

**March 8, 2022 at 6:30 PM**

*Discuss and approve a draft.*

Deadline to submit draft maps:  
February 23. Submit maps to be considered by Council at the January 4 public hearing.

**How can I participate?** You can draw a map of your community! Map-drawing guarantees that communities have the strongest voice possible in expressing their preferences. When residents with similar interests are drawn into a district together, their combined voices give them a greater opportunity to express their views and elect candidates of their choice.
